National Rap Session will feature workshops



The Luxor in Las Vegas will serve as the host hotel for the NALC Rap Session and special training conference to be held April 25-26.

A national Rap Session and special training conference will be held April 25-26 in Las Vegas, Nevada, NALC President William H. Young announced in mid-January. Branch and state association presidents or their designees are invited to attend at the expense of their branches and associations.

The *NALC Constitution* calls for the president to convene a national conference, popularly called a “rap session,” in years when there is no National Convention, and Young noted, “Given the severity of the current economic crisis, I believe it is essential to gather the leadership of our great union in the first half of the year.”

“The NALC and the Postal Service are facing the biggest crisis in decades,” he said. “I hope every branch will send

at least one representative to this important conference.”

The meeting will take place at the Luxor Las Vegas hotel. A welcoming reception will be held the evening of Friday, April 24. At that time, participants will be able to register for workshops to be held on Saturday, April 25. The workshops will be repeated during the day so a maximum number of activists can take advantage of the training. Among the topics to be covered are the results of the Interim Route Adjustment agreement, the economic crisis and its impact on the Postal Service, NALC’s community service agenda, and the whole range of contract administration issues.

President Young will preside over the Rap Session on Sunday morning, April 26.

When this issue went to press, the national union was arranging for a block of group-rate rooms, to be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Details will be posted on the NALC website, nalc.org, and announced in the *NALC Bulletin*. Do not contact the Luxor until the arrangements are completed. ✉
